


# INSTRUCTIONS TO CLAIM CREDIT FOR AN ACADEMY-CERTIFIED CME/CE ACTIVITY

## Step 1

Open a new browser window and type/paste in the TinyURL that was provided in the activity you participated. You should see a screen similar to the following:



## Step 2
